Committee Reports

Resources Committee Report

Barb Dennis reported on the distribution held on Saturday 5/21/2022 at The Hatchery. 93 separate gardens participated in the distribution. Which worked out to about 5 trays or about 40 plants for each garden. Included in the package were vegetables (peppers, tomatoes, etc..) and flowers and herbs.

Barb also reported on the spring bulbs now being offered at New Horizons Garden 401 S. Central Park Ave and a possible mini-distribution this coming Saturday 5/28 of other plants from the greenhouse and city donated bulbs.

Barb indicated the next large distribution is being planned.

Education Committee Report

Lorraine Kells indicated there was nothing special to report except the recent exchange with a staff person, Lilly Peppers, of the Monarchs and Pollinators Team from the Field Museum. They have a Monarch Habitat training program and some virtual workshops. Others wanted to know about the Monarch Habitat training program and JW Glass said he would make a post about this on the CCGA website.

JW Glass reported on the status of the team working to update the community garden list. JW showed the temporary map on the CCGA website.
