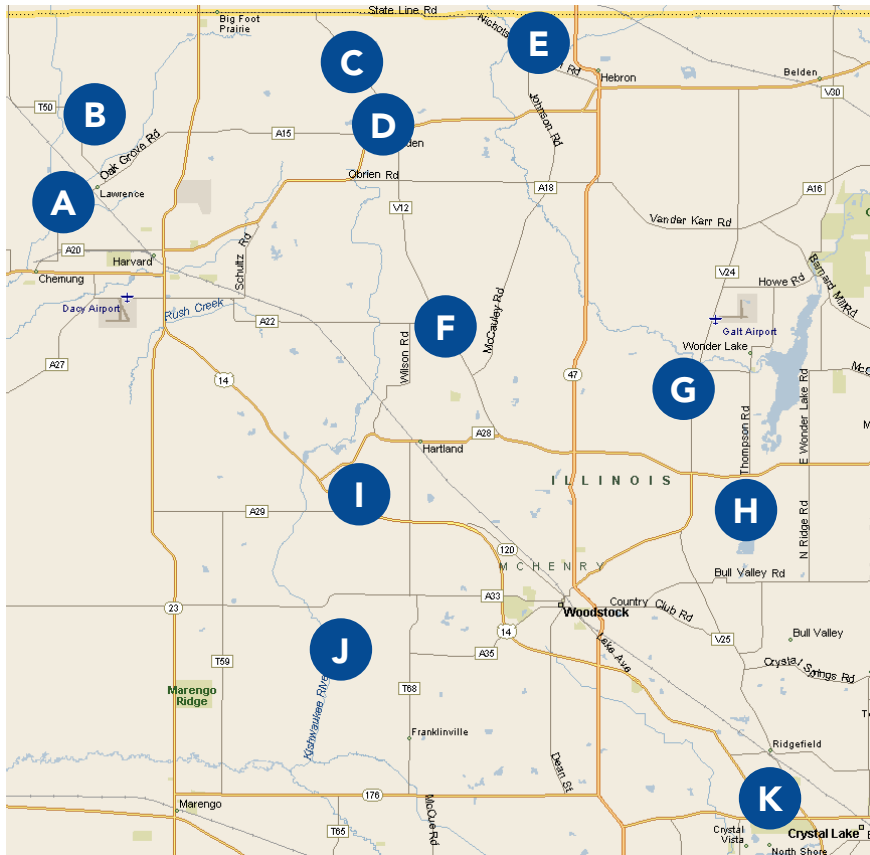

NEW Jorge's Farm | 6710 S Oak Grove Rd., Harvard | A

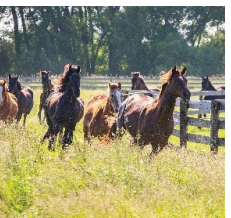
Wanda Farm | 17419 Hebron Rd., Harvard | C
